

REFERRER UPDATE

CONTEXT

The way Linking Leeds accepts referrals is being streamlined to ensure that we are providing the best possible service to everyone that we support, in order to co-produce solutions and identify opportunities to implement what is important to them.

Recent reports have identified that 35% of referrals we receive are for people who are not in a position to engage with the support available.

CHANGES TO REFERRALS

Linking Leeds remains a city-wide service and pathways into the service are still open, but professional referrals will now only be accepted by GPs or primary care staff, unless otherwise agreed with the provider and commissioning body.

Self referrals, carer referrals and non-professional third party referrals will also be accepted.

If you are working with an individual who would benefit from our support, please encourage them to self-refer.

Whilst these changes are being implemented, we'll be focussing on how we as a system can improve the appropriateness of referrals and evaluating whether we can feasibly open more referral routes in the future.
